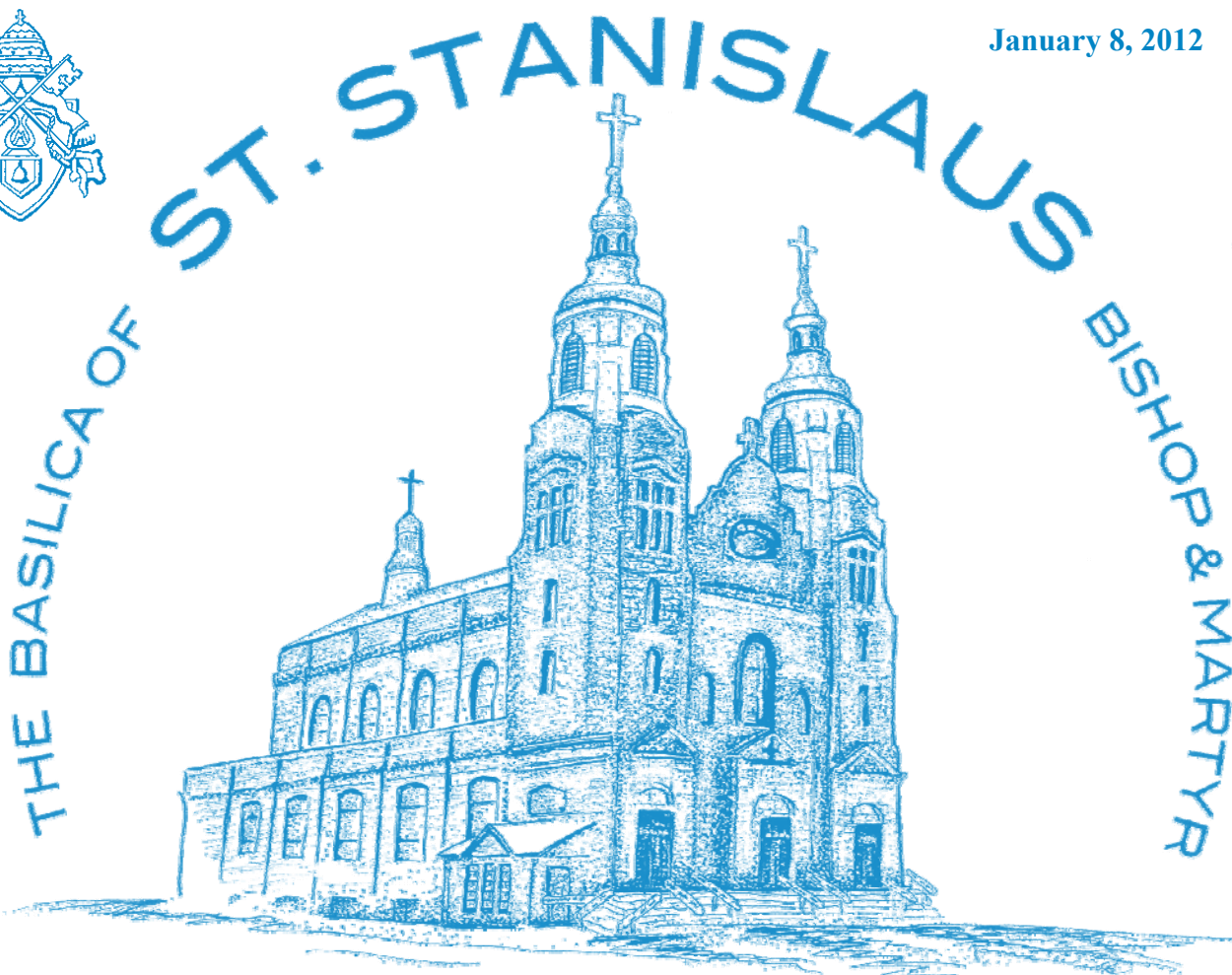

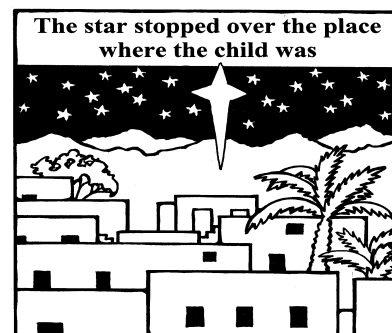

## From the Pastor

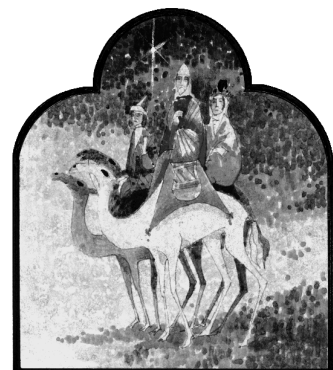
This Sunday we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord, which is the conclusion of the Christmas story and the beginning of the Epiphany Season. Epiphany literally means “manifestation” or “shinning out” or even “radiance.” The Season of Epiphany takes us from the story of the Magi’s visit to the holy season of Lent. Each week, as we hear the Scriptures being proclaimed at Mass, we will focus on the theme: the Good News of Jesus Christ is for all people, of all time, and all places. The Scripture readings for today’s solemnity leave little room for confusion, because even though we are tempted to hear and remember only the visit

of the wise men bearing gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh; all three readings suggest that God is doing great work that takes in the whole world. Tempted though we are to brood over our problems in our little corner of the world, thinking only of our needs and wants, God is doing work that is global in its scope and universal in its importance.

Think for a moment of how our age is more globally focused than any other age in human memory. Everyday we hear the financial news coming from Rome, Athens, Paris, New York, Tokyo, Beijing, Mumbai, and scores of other capitals around the world that seems to speak with one voice: we are in this global economy together without the illusion of removing ourselves from it. Changes are happening whether we like it or not! The prophet Isaiah was speaking of changes happening over 2,000 years ago when he said: “Nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn.” Where in years past, missionaries went to the four corners of the world bearing the Good News of Christ, now missionaries come to the United States. Where would our Polish community be if Fr. Mietek were not here working with us? We are all in God’s family, recipients of gifts God gives us in Jesus Christ.

The Solemnity of the Epiphany reminds us that because of Jesus Christ, His light and life are offered to all people of the world. For us this is nothing new, but when the early Church started to preach this Good News, this news stopped people in their tracks. As St. Paul reminds us in the second reading from his letter to the Ephesians, we are stewards of God’s many and marvelous gifts. Because we are stewards, we are ready and willing to share these gifts. As stewards we know that we are only caretakers; we do not own the gifts; they do not belong to us. They have been freely given to us by our God in and through His Son, Jesus Christ, so, we in turn, share what we have because it was so freely shared with us.

The Season of the Epiphany is given to us so we can hear again our call to discipleship, stewardship, and evangelization. Pope Benedict is dedicating the year 2012 to evangelization; our call to share our faith, not so much by preaching, but by living it everyday. We all know that when someone preaches to us, our eyes begin to glaze over and we look as if we are in a coma. When faith is lived by deeds and actions, we take notice. How are we going to have an Epiphany in and of our faith!?

**HOLY FAMILY RETREAT CENTER** will be offering the following retreats:

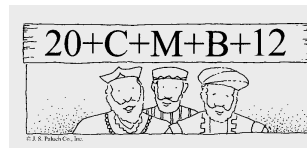

- ✠ Read from the Bible John 1:1-16.
- ✠ The head of the household prays, “The three Wise Men, Kasper, Melchior, and Balthazar, journeyed to Bethlehem to find the Christ Child, and followed the star to God’s Son, who became man. May the peace of Christ rest in our home; may our home be a dwelling of the Lord’s mercy, love, joy, peace, and forgiveness. May all who enter our home experience Jesus Christ in all that we say and do. We ask this through Christ our Lord.”
- ✠ Another member of the family marks the doorpost with the blessed chalk - 20+C+M+B+12 - and then carefully burn the blessed incense.
